

This collection is no exception. Collins explores a wide range of topics in these poems, from the everyday annoyances of modern life to the big questions about what it means to be human. He does so with his trademark wit and humor, but he also never shies away from tackling difficult subjects.

One of the things I love most about Collins's poetry is his ability to find the extraordinary in the ordinary. In the poem "Picnic, Lightning," he describes a family picnic that is interrupted by a sudden thunderstorm. The poem is full of vivid imagery and sensory details, and it captures the feeling of both

wonder and fear that we can experience when we are confronted with the power of nature.

Another poem that I found particularly moving is "The Trouble with Poetry." In this poem, Collins explores the challenges of writing poetry in a world that is often hostile to it. He acknowledges the difficulty of finding the right words and the frustration of not being able to express oneself perfectly.
